NAG2A(b)(i) - Strengths and identified areas for improvement

Strengths -

11 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Ora and Manawa Toa for Korero
12 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Ora for Panui

Identified areas for improvement -

12 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Aki for Te Ine me te Ahuahanga (an improvement from last year when there were 17 out of 18)
6 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Ora for Te Tau me te Taurangi

12 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Aki and Manawa Taki for Tuhituhi (an improvement from last year when there were 15 out of 18)

12 out of 18 taura are achieving Manawa Aki for Te Tauanga me te Tunonotanga (an improvement from last year when there were 15 out of 18)

NAG2A(b)(ii) - The basis for identifying areas for improvement

Results show there is still a need to balance the focus in pangarau so that the students have the opportunities to make shifts in their achievement for all strands.

Results also show that there is a continuing need to work on tuhituhi.

With Te Reo Maori as their second language, students are repetitively taught basic structure and this is reinforced in tuhituhi. Often the students do not go beyond using those structures and lack individual creativity.

Wherefore the students are demonstrating through aromatawai such as Hopukina that they are achieving expected levels of achievement for Korero and Panui, these once again are more focused on structural understanding.

NAG2A(b)(iii) - Planned actions for lifting achievement

Review planning for pangarau to reflect a greater balance of learning opportunities.

Appraisal focusing on identified areas for improvement to ensure ongoing teacher development and reflective practice.

Review and implement digital learning to support programmes (fibre was installed in 2015)

Te Reo Maori in Maori Medium and Assessment PLD through Te Toi Tupu will be undertaken in 2016.

School is also implementing Ra Whai Mana to support boys learning and achievement.

School is part of pilot behaviour programme named Whakamana Tamariki.

NAG2A(b)(iv) - How students are progressing in relation to Ngā Whanaketanga Rumaki Māori

Tuhituhi continues to be an area that requires focusing on.

We need to continue focusing on raising their Reo a Waha to strengthen and help raise achievement in all other marau. This was a focus last year with Te Reo Matatini PLD facilitator, Hinekahukura Te Kanawa and RTL Andrea van Tol. Improvement has been noted and evidenced in their use of te reo Maori.
