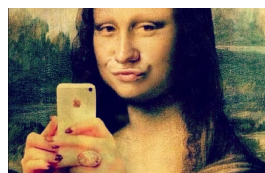
Please read all the notices about the Gala in this newsletter. You can help spread the word by "sharing" the notifications on the school Facebook page and telling others.

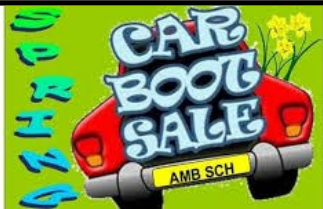

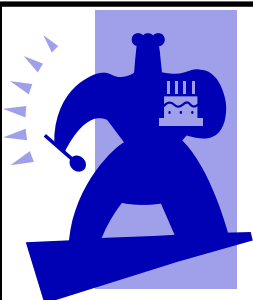
