holidays etc)

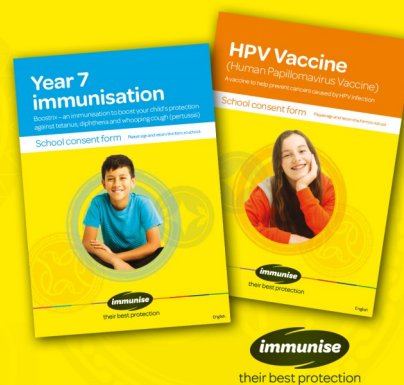
If your child is in **Year 7 or 8** they'll be offered
